



CHRISTAMORE HOUSE GUILD

SCHOLARSHIP (2021-22)

What it is: A need-based scholarship for current and incoming college students awarded on a yearly basis. Scholarship funds are raised by the Christamore House Guild through its annual Book and Author Benefit Luncheon.

Scholarship amount: The amount awarded to each scholar depends on the funds available and the number of eligible applicants; however, the lifetime maximum is **\$10,000** per scholar. The scholarship will not cover entire tuition; other sources of income or financial aid will be necessary.

Who should apply: Students who live in the Haughville area or attend a high school that serves the Haughville area as well as any student who has used services at the Christamore House.

Minimum requirement: A 2.5 G.P.A. (copy of high school and/or college transcripts is required), admission to an accredited college, university or technical school, and demonstration of financial need. A scholar must remain in good standing at his or her institution to continue receiving scholarship funds.

How to apply: Contact the Christamore House Guild Scholarship Committee at *chg.scholarship@gmail.com* for an application.

Application deadline: *May 1, 2021*

Scholar Interview: Scholarship finalists will be invited to an interview with the committee in late May and scholarships will be awarded in June.
