Funds are raised by the Christamore House Guild and its annual Book & Author Benefit Luncheon.

Scholarship Recipients are required to interview in-person with the Christamore House Guild Scholarship Committee in mid to late May and to complete volunteer hours at the Christamore House during the summer and school year.

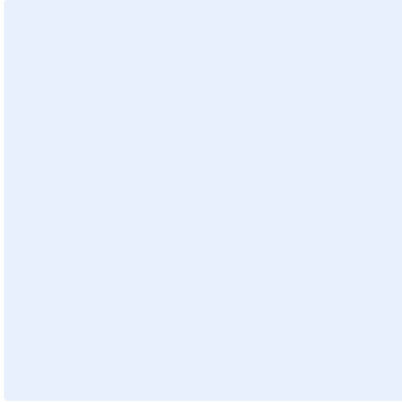

Application Submission Process

1. Submit application by **May 1, 2022** by email to: chg.scholarship@gmail.com.
2. Applicants will be asked to bring a copy of government-issued ID to interview.

Scholarship Requirements

1. The scholarship is for students who wish to pursue full-time studies (12 or more credit hours) for an undergraduate degree at a college, university or technical school. Part-time student status will be considered for residents of the Haughville area.
2. The first-time applicant must live in the boundaries served by the Christamore House or be enrolled in any high school serving these boundaries, which includes Crispus Attucks High School, The Excel Center, George Washington High School, Indianapolis Metropolitan High School, Riverside High School, or Providence Cristo Rey High School.
3. Applicants who live within the boundaries served by the Christamore House or with prior or current involvement in Christamore House programs will be given priority.
4. Applicant must have a semester and cumulative GPA of B (2.5). Applicants with lower than B (2.5) must have compensating qualifications.
5. Applicant must successfully complete 67% of credit hours attempted by semester and cumulatively.
6. Application must be completed in full and submitted on time.
7. Applicant must have applied and been accepted to an approved college or technical school prior to applying.
8. Applicant must have applied to all other sources of financial aid prior to this application. ALL sources of financial aid must be listed on the application. The intent of this award is to SUPPLEMENT other available assistance.
9. Applicant must successfully complete an interview with the Scholarship Committee in mid to late May.
10. Funds will be awarded on a yearly basis and will be paid directly to the scholar's school per semester. FUNDS WILL NOT BE PAID DIRECTLY TO THE STUDENT.
11. Funds will be issued on a semester basis and are to be used in the current semester.
12. Funds will be designated first for tuition; any funds not used for tuition may be applied to other expenses such as books, supplies, and housing depending on the student's financial aid package.
13. Previous scholarship recipients are encouraged to re-apply for assistance each school year.
14. Academic transcripts must be submitted at the end of each semester. A scholar must remain in good standing at his or her school to continue receiving the scholarship. If a scholar falls below good standing, he or she may be placed on a probationary semester.
15. Awards will be granted on the basis of the applicant's relationship with the Haughville community and/or the Christamore House, academic record, recommendations, contributions to school and community, and financial need.
16. Applicant will be notified of the award at the beginning of June.
17. **Applicant must complete required Volunteer Service Hours at the Christamore House by July 31st and December 31st of the year the scholarship is awarded. Volunteer Service Hours requirements are outlined at the end of this Application.**
18. The maximum amount any student may receive from the Christamore House Guild for their lifetime academic career is \$10,000. This amount may change at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee, and does not include the Marge Kroeger Award, which is awarded annually at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee to a senior scholar(s) who demonstrates exceptional volunteerism to the Christamore House.

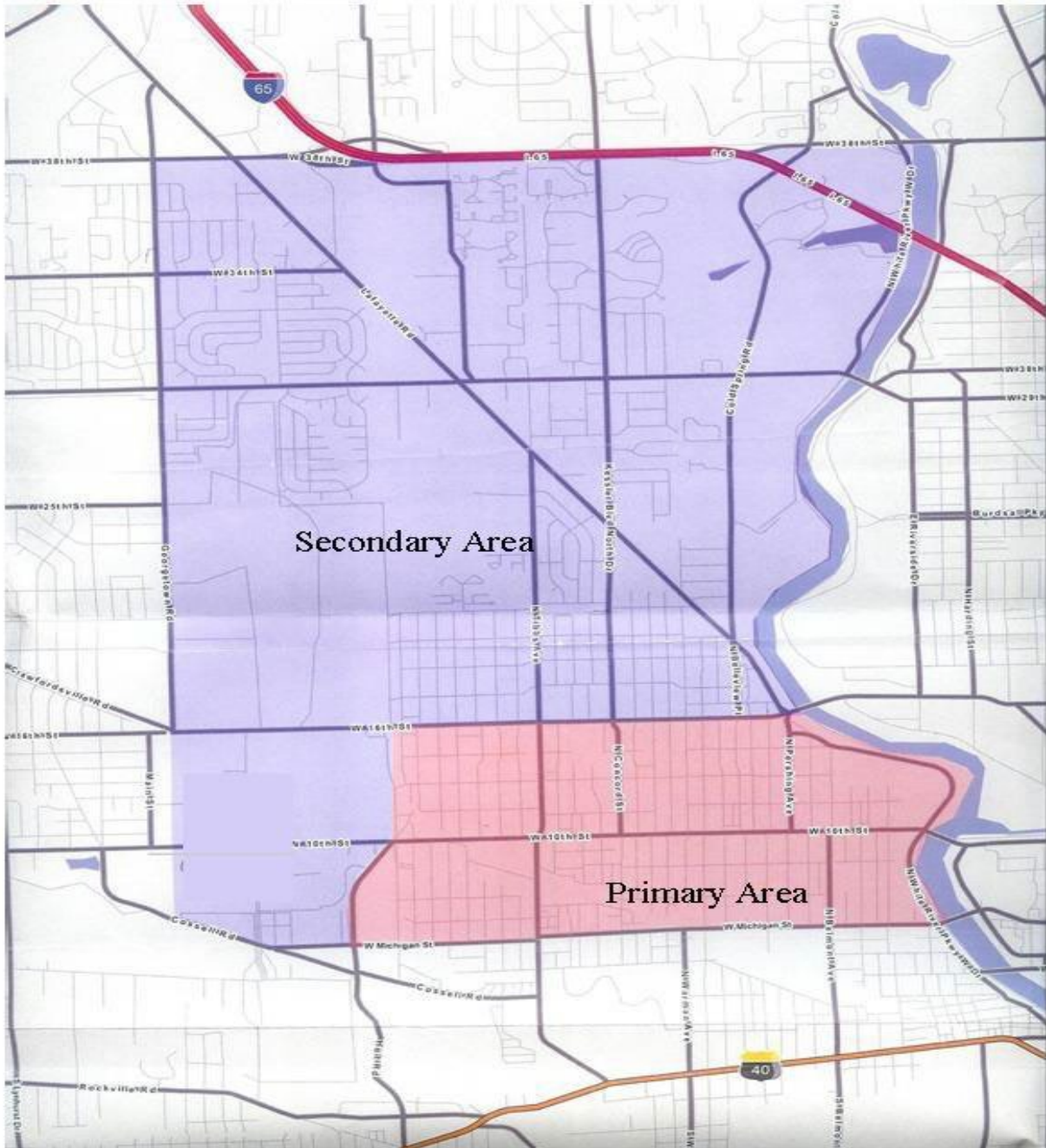

2021-22 Volunteer Service Hours

- Objective:
 - To act as a role model to children using services provided by the Christamore House, including, the preschool, afterschool and summer camp programs; and
 - To support other services and programs sponsored by the Christamore House and/or the Christamore House Guild.

- Required Hours:
 - Each Scholar is required to volunteer at:
 - at least one field trip during the Christamore House Summer Camp, which will operate from June 7 thru July 23; AND
 - at least one Christamore House Holiday event in December.
 - If a Scholar is unable to fulfill the 2 required volunteer opportunities listed above, the Scholar may, with **PRIOR APPROVAL** from the Scholarship Committee, volunteer 10 hours at other sponsored events to satisfy the Volunteer Service Hours requirement.
 - Half of the required Volunteer Service Hours (one Summer Camp field trip or 5 approved hours elsewhere) must be completed by **July 31, 2022**, else the Scholar will forfeit his/her scholarship for the fall semester.
 - ALL **required** Volunteer Service Hours must be completed by **December 31, 2022**, else the Scholar will forfeit his/her scholarship for the spring semester.
 - All Scholars are required to attend a volunteer orientation at the Christamore House, which is currently scheduled for the first week of June.

- Optional Hours:
 - The Christamore House and the Christamore House Guild will periodically publish additional volunteer opportunities for Scholars throughout the year, including, among others:
 - After School Program and Senior Center volunteer opportunities
 - Family Unity Nights
 - Additional Summer Camp volunteer opportunities
 - Book & Author Benefit Luncheon and Reception

- Marge Kroeger Award
 - All Volunteer Service Hours will be tracked per Scholar each year.
 - Senior Scholars may be eligible for the Marge Kroeger Award, which historically has been awarded by the Christamore House Guild at its annual Book & Author Benefit Luncheon (in April) to one or more Senior Scholars who have demonstrated exceptional volunteerism at the Christamore House.
 - The Guild will determine each year, in its sole discretion, whether a Senior Scholar satisfies the criteria for the Award, and the amount of the Award.
